- III. **Nominee's Biography.** Please provide this information as it should appear in promotional and event materials.
- IV. **Misc. Materials**. Materials which demonstrate the nominee's community or legal Contribution, including articles, brochures and other documentation is welcomed but <u>not</u> required.

Please submit all items under the same cover. A nomination will not be considered until all items have been received.

Please note candidates that were nominated last year but not selected will automatically be considered and will have the option to submit updates and/or supplements to their prior application.
