YLD ELECTION CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FY2014-2015

The Young Lawyers Division of the South Carolina Bar is calling for nominations for the positions of **President-Elect**, **Secretary-Treasurer**, **and Even-Numbered Judicial Circuit Representatives**. These positions will become vacant June 30, 2014.

The term of office for the President-Elect and Secretary-Treasurer will be for the 2014-2015 Bar year, which begins on July 1, 2014 and ends on June 30, 2015. The term for the Even-Numbered Circuit Representatives begins on July 1, 2014 and ends on June 30, 2016.

Eligibility Requirements

- A nominee for the office of President-Elect must be eligible to be a member of the Young Lawyers Division for at least two years beginning July 1, 2014.
- A nominee for the position of Secretary-Treasurer and Even-Numbered Circuit
 Representative must be eligible to be a member of the Young Lawyers Division for
 the entire term of the position for which he or she is nominated.
- A nominee for Even-Numbered Circuit Representative must maintain his or her principal office in the circuit to be represented.

Responsibilities/Duties

- The **President-Elect** shall perform such duties as may be assigned to him or her by the President, by the membership, or by the Executive Council. During any period in which the President is unable or refuses to act, the President-Elect shall perform the duties of the President. The President-Elect shall attend all meetings of the Executive Council, unless otherwise excused by the President. The Executive Council meets approximately four times during the fiscal year.
- The **Secretary-Treasurer** shall issue notices of all meetings of the membership and of the Executive Council, keep a record of the proceedings thereof, and perform such other duties as may be assigned to him or her by the President. The Secretary-Treasurer shall attend all meetings of the Executive Council, unless otherwise excused by the President.
- The Circuit Representatives shall serve as the liaisons to the Executive Council from their Judicial Circuit or constituents. In addition to those duties assigned them by the President, or his or her representative, the Circuit Representatives shall attend all regularly scheduled meetings of the Executive Council, unless excused by the President. During the years in which Circuit Representatives serve on the Nominating Committee, they shall attend all meetings called by the Chair of that Committee. The Circuit Representatives may be removed for failure to participate in his or her duties by a two-thirds majority of the Executive Council. Any Circuit Representative who fails to attend two (2) scheduled Executive Council meetings during any one term of office without obtaining prior approval of the President shall be removed from the Council.
- All officers and circuit representatives are expected to attend the 2014-15 YLD Planning Retreat, which will be held in Greenville April 26-27, 2014.

Nominations should be submitted no later than October 25, 2013.
